PRODUCTS ACCEPTED

- Prescription and over-the-counter solid medications, i.e. tablets and capsules.
- Liquid medications, inhalers, creams, ointments, nasal sprays.
- Pet medications.

PRODUCTS NOT ACCEPTED

- Injectables and needles
- Illicit substances

WHY WE ARE COLLECTING

- 70% of people who abuse prescription pain relievers get them from friends or relatives.
- 1 in 4 high school students have abused prescription drugs.
- EPA studies have detected pharmaceutical drugs in our water supply.
- Help protect our youth and environment by safely disposing of medications year-round at one of the medication drop-off boxes listed below.
